I. AGENDA ITEMS

1. Public Hearing for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for Economic Development – Holt Moore, City Attorney

The City of Lumberton is considering applying to the North Carolina Department of Commerce for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for Economic Development.

The CDBG program permits a wide range of development activities to occur which are directed towards promoting the creation or retention of jobs, enhancing income levels and providing local employment opportunities principally for persons of low and moderate income through 1) economic development and 2) public infrastructure. Applications for CDBG assistance must show that at least 60% of the CDBG funds proposed for each activity will benefit low and moderate income persons.

The purpose of the Hearing is to obtain citizens input into the identification of economic needs and desired economic development activities. The input from this Hearing will be incorporated into the City's consideration and submission of a CDBG application to the Department of Commerce. A previous Public Hearing was held on March 11, 2019, but due to an error in the advertisement of that hearing, another advertisement and Public Hearing are required. Opportunity to submit written comments prior to the opening of the Public Hearing will be considered; if any were submitted.

That Council conduct the public hearing and render a decision.

Mayor Davis opened a public hearing concerning the submission of an application for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).
